

# GRŴP BAE HIRAEI

Some of us have had letters from Gwynedd Planning saying that the latest amended plans are now available regarding the revised Access onto the former Dickies Boatyard site. You have until 19/08/2011 to make observations on them.

Unfortunately the plans are only available on the Council's Track and Trace system or at the Planning Office, Ffordd y Cob, Pwllheli LL53 5AA. The reference number is C09A/0410/11/LL and the date registered is 29-Aug-2009.

- The new access onto the site will be where we wanted it, at the far side of the Social Club leading from a new mini-roundabout on Beach Road about where the bus stops are now.
- It is not clear that a Public Enquiry will be held into changing the route of the existing Glandŵr Road. ( this involves moving a section of it eastwards to line up with the new access road to the East of the Social Club, and making the road between the garage and the Social Club into what looks like a bridle way.)
- If you do use the Council's Track and Trace system the new plans are at the bottom of the list of documents. Before you print them check they have this year's date on. Two are site plans and two relate to the mini-roundabout.
- Grŵp Bae Hirael have protested about the lack of paper copies available to the public
- At present we are not planning to object to the amended access plans
